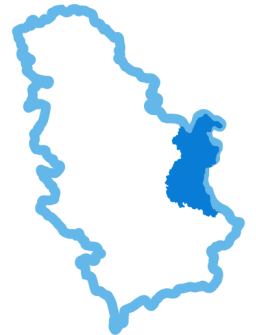

The tour includes a visit to Knjazevac, Boljevac and Negotin

FIRST DAY (optional)

Arrival from the direction of Nis or Sokobanja and drive to Knjazevac

Knjazevac



- The native museum of Knjaževac, which houses a world-unique exhibition of double-spun woolen socks.
- Visit to the ethnic association for the preservation of tradition "Izvor", which deals with making souvenirs, cultivating traditional cuisine, folk speech, singing, training young people in the spirit of recognizing and preserving tradition.
- Ravna archaeo-ethno park. Within the park, there are numerous monuments from the Roman period, as well as exhibits from the Timacum Minus site (the oldest military fortification in the Timok region). There are reconstructed Serbian houses from the 19th century and a museum of viticulture and winemaking.
- Overnight stay. Recommendation: Gorski Konak in the village of Zubetinac near Knjazevac. Gorski Konak has 14 beds in 5 rooms and suites. Each room and apartment has its own bathroom and toilet. Guests can enjoy the swimming pool and the Finnish bio sauna, next to which there is a heated area for rest and enjoyment with relaxing music.

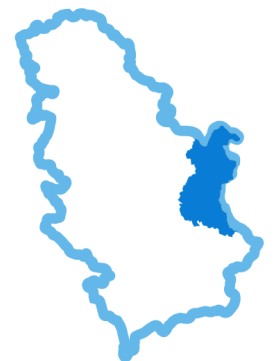

SECOND DAY (optional)

Boljevac – Rtanj

- In the settlement of Rtanj, which was built next to a former mine at the foot of the mountain, you can visit the old mining shaft and the beautiful Gretin Park, which is next to the settlement itself. As part of your visit at the foot of the mountain, you can take a walk along the health trail and visit the ethnic settlement to which the trail takes you.
- Etno house Iliino - the house was built at the end of the 19th century, it belonged to the Savic family until 1926. It was completely reconstructed and turned into the Native House of the sculptor Ljubinka Savic - Grasi in September 2009.
- Overnight stay. Recommendation: ethnic object Onomad in the village of Iliino. ONOMAD is located in the center of the village, 100m from the spring Iliino. It consists of two renovated houses, a yard, a stable, a basket, a wine cellar and the first library in the village. Accommodation relies on tradition, natural resources and at the same time provides all the conditions of modern accommodation for up to 8 people. The guests of the household like to spend most of their time in the pool-bar, which is heated throughout the season.



THIRD DAY (optional)

Rajac wine cellars

- The wine cellars in the village of Rajac are located on a hill and the complex consists of 270 cellars around a central square with a fountain. The cellars are partially buried in the ground. They are known for the production of red wines. During the visit, wine tasting is organized in beer halls.

- Wine cellars in Rogljevo - There are well-known wine cellars in the village of Rogljevo. They have a slightly different architecture and are characterized by extremely high-quality red and white wine. You must visit them.
- Lunch, optional dinner and overnight stay. Recommendation: Rural tourist household "Jovanovic" in Rogljevo, which offers tourist accommodation in the countryside, in addition to the famous cellar, gastronomic tourism services in the countryside and its cellar in the authentic location of the Rogljevo wine cellars. They also offer a large number of domestic natural products: wine, brandies, liqueurs, winter wine. The wine cellars that dates back to 1873. it has been renovated in ethnic style so that it can accommodate group and individual visits. Around 25 guests can be comfortably accommodated in the beer hall.

Package price: It will be formed in cooperation with local travel agencies.

Product Timeframe: Three days.

Sales channel: Receptive travel agencies, members of the Cluster "Magic of the East" - "Sedmica plus" Negotin, "Aster" Bor and "Djerdap travel" Majdanpek.
