Gastronomy - a large selection of dishes from the national cuisine of Eastern Serbia with traditional drinks

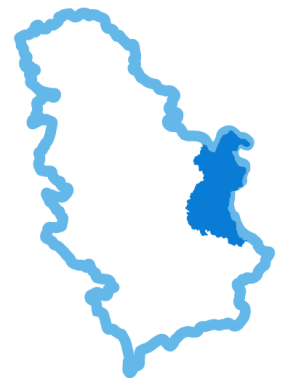
The tour includes a visit to Knjazevac, Zajecar, Bor and Negotin

FIRST DAY (optional)

Arrival from the direction of Nis or Sokobanja and drive to Knjazevac

Knjazevac

- The native museum of Knjazevac, which houses a world-unique exhibition of double-spun woolen socks.
- Visit to the ethnic association for the preservation of tradition "Izvor", which is engaged in the production of souvenirs and the preservation of traditional cuisine. The association has its own collection of ancient costumes. Some exhibits are over 100 years old.
- Ravna archaeo-ethno park. Within the park there are numerous monuments from the Roman period, as well as exhibits from the Timacum Minus site. There are reconstructed Serbian houses from the 19th century and a museum of viticulture and winemaking.
- Accommodation, Recommendation - Gorski Konak in the village of Zubetinac near Knjazevac. Gorski Konak has 14 beds in 5 rooms and suites. Each room and apartment has its own bathroom and toilet. Guests can enjoy the swimming pool and the Finnish bio sauna, next to which there is a heated area for rest and enjoyment with relaxing music.

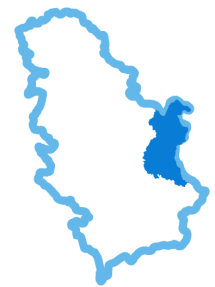


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SECOND DAY (optional)

Zajecar

- A walk through the city with a tour of the National Museum, the Nikola Pasic Memorial and the Church of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The church was built in 1839 by order of Prince Milos Obrenovic, and the current icon painting dates from 1877.
- Recommendation - Caffe - patisserie Stella Lux Zajecar, located on the town square. It offers traditional cakes, tarts, as well as well-known ice cream. In addition, a wide selection of refreshing drinks during the summer months and salep that can warm you up on cold days.
- Lunch, Recommendation - Irish Pub Rivendell Zajecar - This iconic place was founded more than 20 years ago. The building consists of a restaurant, a greenhouse and a garden. Guests can enjoy a rich gastronomic offer and a rich selection of cocktails that are the best in town.
- Felix Romuliana archaeological site. The late antique castle of the Roman emperor Gaius Valerius Maximilian Gallery. It stands out with beautiful floor mosaics and sculptures. Since June 2007. it is included in the list of World Cultural Heritage under the auspices of UNESCO.



Bor

- A panoramic view of Bor and the surface mine of one of the largest copper mines in Europe. The visit includes a tour of French architecture in Bor (Mining Faculty Building, RBN Administration Building, Hospital).
- Visit to the museum in Bor, where there is a unique display of mining and metallurgy and the history of mining in this region.
- Accommodation and stay, Recommendation - Hotel Albo in Bor. It is located at the entrance to Bor and has 76 beds. The hotel's restaurant stands out for its distinctive cuisine. The menu includes traditional dishes and a large selection of drinks.

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THIRD DAY (optional)

Negotin

- A walk through the old city center with a tour of the Church of the Holy Trinity and the Church of the Most Holy Theotokos, as well as the birthplace of Stevan Stojanovic Mokranjac, the greatest Serbian composer, from the mid-19th century. The house is now an exhibition space and museum.
- Visit to the residence of Prince Todorcet, built in the middle of the 19th century. Konak is the oldest preserved village house in Negotin.
- The Krajina Museum - For almost 90 years, the Krajina Museum has preserved evidence of the rich history and traditions of the Negotin Krajina. Under the auspices of the Museum are centuries-old spiritual and secular buildings as well as ancient sites that give a special historical value to the Negotin Region.
- Lunch, Recommendation - Winery "Matalj" in Negotin. Matalj winery cultivates its 20ha of vineyards within three vineyards in the region of Negotin Krajina. In the winery, you will enjoy a fantastic selection of food and top wines of your choice or the selection of the staff of the Winery.
- Visit to the Bukovo Monastery, which belongs to the Eparchy of Timok. The monastery church is dedicated to the Holy Father Nicholas the Wonderworker. The monastery is known for the production of the famous wines and brandy of Negotin Krajina.

Package price: It will be formed in cooperation with local travel agencies.
